Complex cases will include without limitation those presenting a possible maximum sentence of life in prison, cases with multiple charges or cases with multiple defendants. Applicants will have had demonstrated experience in cases of this nature.

Auxiliary Panel

Members of the Auxiliary Panel will handle such matters as misdemeanor offenses within federal jurisdiction and material witness representation.

Appeal/Habeas Panel

Members of the Appeal/Habeas panel will handle direct appeals to the Tenth Circuit, district court representation in 2241, 2254 and 2255 proceedings or related litigation, such as was seen in connection with the *Johnson* and the First Step Act cases. **Please attach a writing sample to your application if applying for this panel.**
